### Q: Will every learner who applies receive a scholarship?

A: No. SANRAL receives many scholarship applications from learners across South Africa and, unfortunately, we have only a **limited number of scholarships** to give out each year. But don't let that discourage you! If you are motivated to excel in your studies, you should still apply for this opportunity.

### **Q:** How does SANRAL select the scholarship recipients?

A: The selection process is strictly applied.

Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of academic merit and financial need. The background of the learner is also taken into consideration. SANRAL reserves the right to decline applications from a designated group once the target for that group has been reached.

### Q: How will I know if my scholarship application was successful?

A: SANRAL will contact successful candidates only – once the final selection process has been completed. If you have not received any communication within three months from the application closing date, it means that your application was unsuccessful. Unfortunately, we cannot provide individual feedback on unsuccessful applications.

### Q: Does receiving a SANRAL scholarship guarantee employment with <u>SANRAL?</u>
